With the implementation of the New Curriculum, all staff are embracing the changes and are offering a range of exciting and engaging experiences for all children, with pupil voice at the heart of learning. Our whole school topic this term is 'Dyma Ni' (All About us).



As part of the new curriculum and our new school vision, we have enlisted the help of our wonderful

children to help design various elements of Ysgol Derwenfa's new brand. The past few weeks the children have been busy designing new logos and characters to represent the four purposes. We are also extremely excited about having a mural painted on the side of the school – all designed by the children of Ysgol Derwenfa – to reflect our school values and the history of Leeswood itself. We really enjoyed hearing old tales from our Chair of Governors Ray Hughes and Mr Carlton Jones, which helped inspire our designs.



At Ysgol Derwenfa we prioritize pupil voice. We are very proud of our pupils and their appetite for learning and their enthusiasm towards all the new changes. We have resurrected 'School Council' and 'Criw Cymraeg' which will help raise standards of the Welsh language spoken in school, with the hope of achieving our Bronze Award this year. We have also appointed Digital Leaders in KS2 who will undergo training to become Digital Heroes, with a view to reach out to the community. Over the next few weeks we will also have Sport Leaders and Sports Council – something Mr J Jones is passionate about.

Fridays are very important at Ysgol Derwenfa. 


Hello,

Ysgol Derwenfa Nurture – Miss Sieminski's Class




